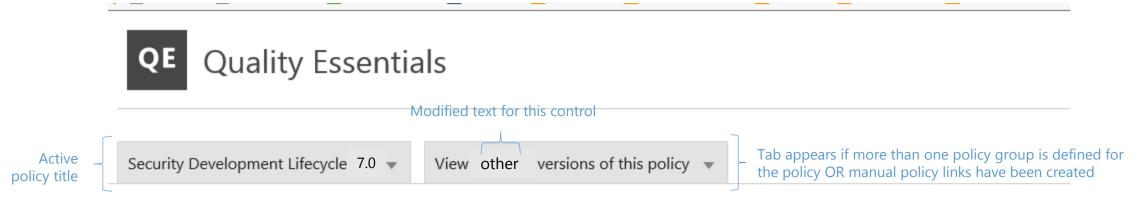

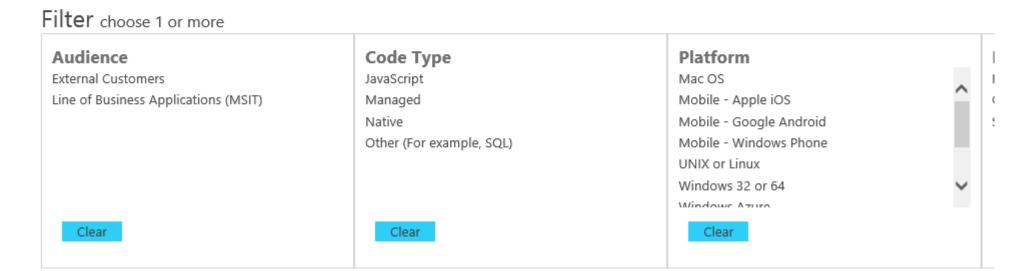
## Acceptance Criteria Basics
